Alcoholic drinks

Chocolate – milk chocolate – mildly toxic

Bakers or Bittersweet chocolate – vary toxic

Coffee – grounds or beans

Fruit pits or seeds – apple, apricot, cherry, peach, pear

Garlic

Grapes and raisins

Macadamia nuts – only 6 can be deadly

Yeast dough

Cigarettes

Candy and gum containing

Medicines

Advantix and OTC flea and tick products (OK for dogs, fatal to cats)

Anti-depressants

Anti-inflammatories: aspirin, ibuprofen, Tylenol

Cold medicines – all

Dental floss – easily swallowed by kittens and puppies

Diet pills

Suppositories – dangerous to cats
